



2010 LEGISLATIVE AGENDA

LEGISLATION WSCADV WILL BE PRIORITIZING

- Maintaining funding for domestic violence shelter and legal advocacy.
- Maintaining basic safety net programs that support domestic violence survivors, including housing/homelessness, General Assistance (GA-U) and Basic Health, and childcare programs.
- Ensuring the family law and child custody process protects domestic violence survivors.
- Strengthening protections available and the availability of protection orders for domestic violence survivors.

LEGISLATION WSCADV WILL BE MONITORING

- State agency reorganization and placement developments.
- Providing increased county revenue options and spending flexibility.
- Restrictions on firearms for domestic violence perpetrators.
- Enhanced sentencing guidelines for felony domestic violence convictions.
- Guidelines addressing deferred prosecution and sentencing.
- Enhancing 911 service-delivery.
- Protecting information about domestic violence history from being disclosed in the residential tenant screening process.
- Legislation related to providing services, including housing, assistance for families in the child welfare system.
- Technology safety and privacy-related issues.
