LEGISLATION WSCADV WILL BE PRIORITIZING

- Revenue options to support funding for safety net programs that support domestic violence survivors.
- Maintaining funding for domestic violence shelter and legal advocacy.
- Maintaining basic safety net programs that support domestic violence survivors, including housing/homelessness, TANF and State Family Assistance Programs.
- Protecting the confidentiality and privacy of information pertaining to domestic violence victims

LEGISLATION WSCADV WILL BE MONITORING

- Enhancing protections for stalking victims.
- Restrictions on firearms for domestic violence perpetrators.
- Guidelines addressing reduced sentencing and supervision for domestic violence offenders.
- Training for various professionals that interact with domestic violence survivors
- Protecting information about domestic violence history from being disclosed in the residential tenant screening process.
- Mandatory reporting obligations for domestic violence service agencies and other health and human service providers.
